## Call for Nominations IFA Jolly Award Committee

Nominations are being called for the NW Jolly Medal, for presentation at the Institute's [\*Forests for healthy cities, farms and people Conference\*](#) to be held in conjunction with Australian Forest Growers at University House, ANU, Canberra in September 2018. The NW Jolly Medal is the Institute's highest and most prestigious honour for outstanding service or contribution to forestry in Australia.

The Committee encourages nominations from across the full scope of forestry and reflecting the current diversity of significant contributions being made across a wide range of disciplines and forest management purposes. In this context, forestry includes the sustainable management, development and use of all forests for the manifold goods and services that forest ecosystems provide whether for public, private or commercial purposes, including education, research and development, forest policy and all types of forest land management. This contribution may include work in international forestry where this has enhanced the reputation of Australian forestry at an international level.

Any financial Voting Member of the Institute may nominate a person for the N.W. Jolly Medal. The nominee does not need to be a member of the IFA. Another financial Voting Member should second the nomination. Each nomination must be accompanied by a one-page citation in support on the nomination. Up to five pages of additional information detailing the nominee's work and publications may also be submitted.

The nominator may seek information from the person being nominated but nominations should be submitted on a confidential basis.
