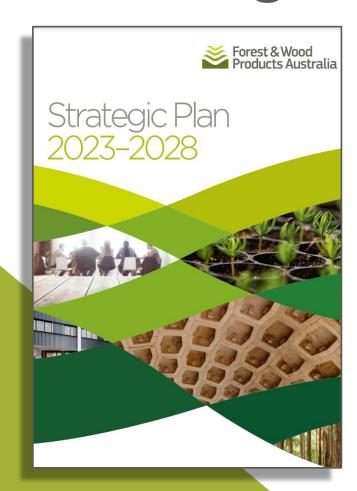








Strategic Plan 2023 - 2028

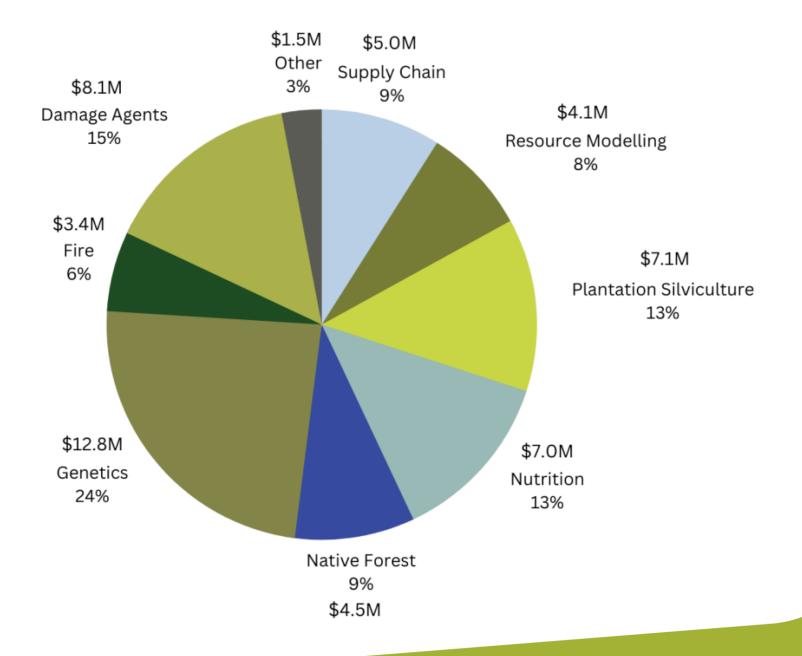

FIELD TRIALS

- 44 different materials
- Ground proximity and sandwich tests
- Bending test specimens
- Two sites- near Brisbane and Far North Queensland (>3 m rain/yr)

Objective: Identify pathways for reuse/recycling

ASSESS TREATABILITY OF AUSTRALIAN SOFTWOOD RESOURCE

- -Part of a larger project to assess the MGP grading program
- -Collected ~2500 pieces of softwood from across country to assess treatability with CCA & LOSP in relation to wood properties
- -Data to be used by producers but also feed into breeding programs





FIRE PERFORMANCE

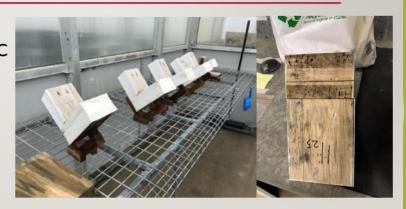
- · Bushfire risks are increasing

Objective: Assess effect of wetting on connections in hardwood CLT





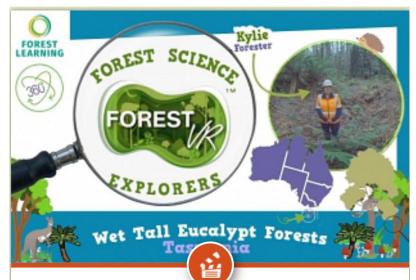
Statistics and Economics

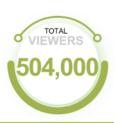
